

This year, some states are requiring that tax preparers collect driver's license information from all of their clients. Maine is **not** one of these states. However, our tax program has implemented a new page for this information, and it is **impossible to file** without filling it out. We must fill out this page, **either** with your I.D. information **or** by stating that you refused to give us that information.

As a result, we've devised this new form. Please either write the following information, or sign the statement at the bottom of the page to say that we gave you the option to give us your I.D. information but you elected not to. Again, this is not required information in the state of Maine.
